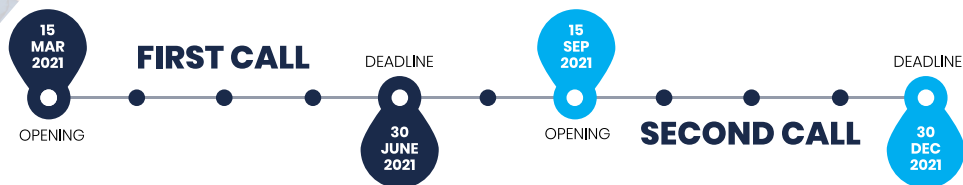

Up to **50 fellows will be recruited in two calls** announced in 2021. In the first call 35 fellows and in the second call 15 fellows will be selected.




Who can apply?

researchers of any nationality, with PhD or at least 4 years of equivalent research experience who have spent in Poland max. 12 months during the three years prior to the call's deadline



How to apply?

Before applying for the PASIFIC Fellowship, you need to **identify a suitable PAS institute and a prospective supervisor**, who will commit to support your research.

In cooperation with the host institute and a prospective supervisor, you should prepare an application to be submitted to the online system that will be open **from 15.03.2021 to 30.06.2021** (Call 1) and **15.09.2021 to 30.12.2021** (Call 2).

The application will consist of an online administrative form and include following documents:

- CV and track record of scientific achievements
- research project description (max. 10 pages)
- supervisor's CV and description of project's impact on the institute's research environment (to be prepared jointly with the institute's representatives)
- ethics self-assessment (if necessary)
- scanned PhD diploma or documents confirming the equivalent 4-year research experience
- scanned letter confirming support from the prospective supervisor and host institution
